Subject: Routine Testing Of Groundwater For CB

I plan to set up this testing program in the following manner.

1. As in the past, sample analysis will be done at ESL. Sharon Laas says that 5 or 6 samples twice a year will be no problem compared to the blood testing they are doing for us. Their efforts to find an outside laboratory to do this work have so far been unsuccessful, and so they will be running this analysis for the foreseeable future.

2. Sampling frequency will be once every 6 months, as you suggested.

3. These samples will be taken.

- Little Hocking Water System
- Lubeck Water System
- Plant Drinking Water
- Well Number 27
- Letart Upper Pond
- Letart Lower Pond

4. Jim Yoak tells me that the Letart samples are taken once a month, and although CB analysis is requested, it has never been run. Thus, it makes sense to include them.

5. In years past, samples from public water systems have been obtained by having a laboratorian drive to a gas station or general store and ask to refill a jug of drinking water. Although adequate for an occasional sample, this procedure is not a good one to use on a routine basis. Instead, I intend to ask a Du Pont employee living in each water district to get the sample from a home tap not connected to a water softener.

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
