I have been over your revision of Treon's paper. Editorially I have no comments at all. Technically I do not see why it belongs in our Journal. The only possible justification for putting it in our Journal, as compared with one on straight toxicology, is the last sentence in your opening paragraph, and I do not think that is enough.

Please look at this from our point of view. We have to be a bit stiff about what we take.
