## Notable Accomplishments

The Colorado Legislative Sportsmen's Caucus and CSF are pleased to highlight a few notable accomplishments in Colorado:

- In 2018, Colorado Legislative Sportsmen's Caucus members played a leadership role in passing Senate Bill 143, the Hunting, Fishing and Parks for Future Generations Act, legislation that seeks to increase the number of hunters and anglers in Colorado, expand sportsmen's access and modernize the state's fish hatchery system, among other priorities.
- During the 2017 legislative session, Colorado Legislative Sportsmen's Caucus leadership successfully blocked legislative proposals to limit Colorado Parks and Wildlife's ability to conduct research on predator impacts to ungulate species in the Piceance Basin and the Arkansas River Valley.
- Over the past several years, CSF has worked with Colorado members of the Congressional Sportsmen's Caucus including Senators Cory Gardner and Michael Bennet and Representatives Scott Tipton and Jared Polis to advance priorities including the Target Practice and Marksmanship Training Support Act, legislation to allow archery hunters to carry bows across National Park Service lands and the Recovering America's Wildlife Act.

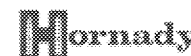
