

C HEAT LAMP REFLECTOR

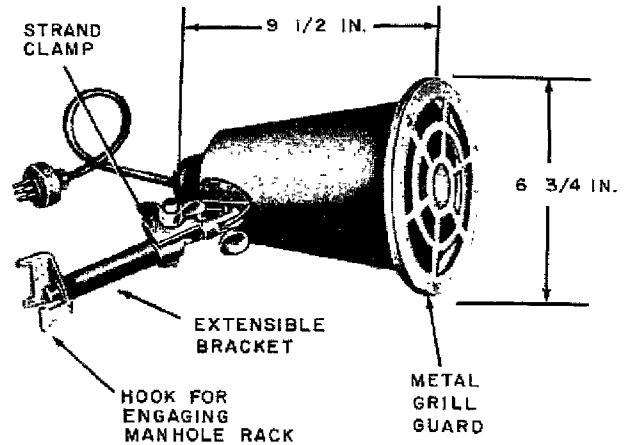
The C heat lamp reflector, when equipped with a 115- to 125-volt infrared lamp, provides heat and illumination in cable splicing operations in cold weather. When heat is not required, the infrared lamp can be replaced with a 75- or 100-watt rough service bulb for lighting purposes. The reflector may be used aerially as well as underground.
