Dear Emmett:

I would like to report to you regarding the outbreak of chlor-acne at Nitro. There have been a total of 114 cases since March 8th, 1949, when the condition developed. There has been only one re-occurrence and that case is now cured. There are eleven cases off from work now and there are forty-eight cases now under treatment. The last case occurred prior to September 18th, when it developed seven new cases among men doing roofing and repair work to Building 41 where the incident occurred. These cases were very mild, however, and are now cured. There were four active cases terminated at their request to go to work in other plants, and I have no follow up on them except that I know they are being treated under the Workmen's Compensation laws just as though they were working here. I have had no report from Cincinnati regarding the four cases we sent. Undoubtedly you will receive such a report as soon as I do. The cases now under treatment in Charleston are divided between Dr. Boggs and Dr. Bonar. While their methods of treatment vary somewhat, most of the cases seem to be progressing satisfactorily, and I think the general morale of the men involved is fairly good. Several of the cases are still pretty severe and undoubtedly it will be many months before they will be completely cured. I shall try to write again after the 1st of the year and give you a little more information as it develops.
