

ASBESTOS BIBLIOGRAPHY 1965-1976

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INTRODUCTION

The subject of this bibliography is asbestos, its analysis and presence as a health hazard or pollutant. The scope is ten years, from 1965 to the present.

The entries, which are numbered consecutively, have been arranged into eleven subject categories, subarranged chronologically, most recent work first, and within each year alphabetically by author. An author index is added at the back.

The eleven subject categories have been grouped in three broad areas: analysis, toxicology, and background levels and efforts to control. This last area is not subdivided. The analytical section has been divided mainly by methods of analyses, with preference to electron microscopy. Section I.B., "By Other Methods" contains references to other specific methods of analysis, whereas I.C., "By Mixed and Misc. Methods" contains references which involved several methods or did not specify the methods used. A different approach is reflected in I.D., "In Liquids" which contains reference to analysis of asbestos in liquid samples, as opposed to asbestos in air.

In the toxicology section, II.A., "Toxicology in General" contains references which are broad considerations of the asbestos problem, in contrast to the other divisions which consider specific aspects. The distinction between II.B., "Asbestos-Related Cancer in Humans" and II.C., "Experimental Cancer Studies," is that II.B. considers only actual human cancer cases whereas II.C. includes animal studies and cell cultures. Some human cancer cases also appear in II.D., "Occupational Hazards of Asbestos," but here the emphasis is on exposure to asbestos in the workplace, not on the mechanisms of disease. Finally, II.E. and II.F. consider references to asbestos as a pollutant in the general environment. Any mention of asbestos in water or food or beverages has sufficed to place a reference in II.F., "Asbestos in Water or Ingestibles," even if air pollution is also considered.
