If the Employee has received Total and Permanent Disability Benefit payments under the Group Policy, the amount of Life Insurance shall be the amount otherwise applicable to him reduced by the amount of Life Insurance with respect to which such Total and Permanent Disability Benefits were paid."

Note: (a) The amounts of insurance specified in Column A above shall become effective on the later of (i) the last regularly scheduled working day prior to the Applicable Date specified in Column A, provided the Employee is actively at work on such date, otherwise on the date of his return to active work and (ii) the effective date of the Employee's certificate.

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(b) The increased amounts of insurance specified in Column B above shall become effective on the later of (i) the Applicable Date specified in Column B, provided the Employee is actively at work on such date, otherwise on the date of his return to active work and (ii) the effective date of the Employee's certificate.
