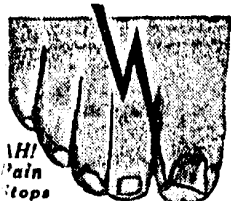


The members of the Tracy

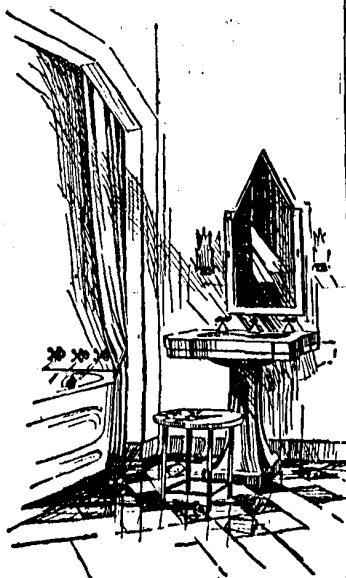
