Dear Dr. Cholak:

The Paint Research Institute, of which I am Director, is the high level research arm of the Paint Industry. We establish Research Projects in various Universities and other Institutions to carry on Fundamental Research which we hope might ultimately be of service to our Industry.

Among other items, we are naturally interested in Lead Toxicology, especially in connection with some cases of Lead Poisoning in children, mostly in slum areas in Baltimore and New York. It has been suggested that we should sponsor some work on several phases of Lead Toxicology, e.g.,

- (1) A thorough literature survey
- (2) Development of methods to detect lead in small quantities in tissue
- (3) Study of possibility of experiments with animals as a means to judge results in small children and other phases.

Your name has been suggested as one man I should contact to see whether your organization would be interested in working on any, or all phases of this Lead Toxicology, or whether you can direct us to intelligent efforts or who might undertake such work.
