2 fair and reasonable for the pain and suffering that
3 Mr. Grewe went through.

4 His Honor told you what the factors are to
5 be taken into account, the effect of the injury, the
6 disfigurement, the noneconomic loss, the mental
7 anguish.

8 You heard about how Mr. Grewe loved his
9 family, how he liked his grandchildren, how he did
10 things for his grandchildren around the house, how he
11 was told in December of 1992 that basically we are
12 sorry, Mr. Grewe, you have an incurable disease, there
13 is nothing we can do for you anymore.

14 Do you remember what he told you about what
15 his plans were in life? He wanted to retire and
16 travel around the country. At 56 years of age, he is
17 a prisoner in his own house and dies a terrible
18 death.

19 Now, with respect to the claims for
20 compensatory damages in favor of Nancy Grewe as
21 surviving spouse, and there are three separate
