In your memo you asked whether or not Aroclor 1242 based on biphenyl as a byproduct of BXT operations would be satisfactory for NCR's application. Answer - we do not know. By copy of this memo, I am requesting C. Paton to contact Bill Kuhn to determine what work was done, and if samples remain. The only way to determine if satisfactory is to sample NCR. This we could do in a disguised manner.

We are currently selling Aroclor 5060 and Aroclor 5460 to Sun Chemical. Sales year to date are as follows:

Aroclor 5060 44,000 pounds

Aroclor 5460 88,000 pounds

Koppers' production of Aroclor 5060 and 5460 competitors were based on Dow taraphen D-25. This is a terphenyl stream, not biphenyl. To the best of our knowledge, Koppers has never made chlorinated biphenyls, only terphenyls.
