I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of May 29th, on the subject of registration of the word "Anaconda" with the trade-mark by the Glidden Company.

Our legal department, both Col. Shores and Mr. Wolf, are so busy on matters of vast importance that we cannot bring this question up with them at this time. Personally, I think if they will transfer the registration to us that it might cover the case satisfactorily.

We do not, however, appreciate their action in doing this. I cannot see how the trade mark bureau of the Paint & Varnish Association would issue a trade mark that had previously been taken out by some one else, and I understand that this is the case when we applied for the Anaconda trade-mark.

I think to close up the matter it is advisable to have the transfer of the registration made to us.
