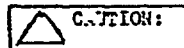

Subject: Asbestos Content Label

In the very near future, asbestos containing gasket materials and specialty papers sold by Armstrong will carry the following notice of content and instructions regarding the proper usage of this material.



This material contains asbestos fibers. Avoid creating dust. Follow approved work practices including the use of appropriate dust control equipment. Inhalation of asbestos fibers may cause asbestosis or other serious bodily harm. Smoking greatly increases this risk of serious bodily harm.

Asbestos fibers in our materials are locked in a matrix of rubber latex binders; however, use of these materials requires appropriate measures be observed in their fabrication, handling, installation, removal and disposal. Accordingly, the above notice will be affixed to the roll near the product identification label on each shipment unit. For your use, self-stick notices are available for purchase at \$45.00 per thousand.
