

1 We ought to really get to his
2 recommendations if we are going to talk about it,
3 sir.

4 Q The .21 that Roberts reported led to this
5 being written in the paper; is that correct?

6 A I suspect that that is correct, yes.

7 Q And, in fact, within the discussion section
8 it was reported based on the time-weighted average of
9 .21, when the results are compared to the NIOSH
10 recommended standards in which the eight-hour TWA
11 exposure to asbestos is .1 fibers, I think it is 35
12 PMCC --

13 A No, it is greater than five microns.

14 Q That is a greater-than sign. Thank you.
15 With a ceiling exposure of .5 fibers greater than five
16 microns for any 15-minute sampling period, most of the
17 exposures to brake servicing mechanics indicate
18 concentrations which exceed these recommendations.

19 Isn't that one of the discussions points in
20 Mr. Roberts' papers?

21 A Yes, but the first and foremost one is
