8 three, were designated by Corning Glass Works, which
9 was the other parent company, and Mr. Boeschenstein
10 was a director.

11 He was the seventh one and, of course, held
12 the balance of power, if there was ever a question of
13 balance of power.

14 Does that answer your question?

15 Q Yes. Were the three individuals who were
16 designated by Owens-Illinois also on -- I am sorry.
17 Let me try that again.

18 Were the three individuals who were
19 designated by Owens-Illinois also on the Board of
