Dear Dr. Zapp:

Your name was given to us over the telephone this morning by Dr. Shield with the American Conference of Industrial Hygienists in Cincinnati. Dr. Shield stated that you were a member of a committee referred to as Z-34 Industrial Hygiene Committee and that you may be able to assist us.

We desire to obtain as soon as possible any information or literature concerning the standard or threshold limit values on the inhalation of asbestos dust set by your committee at any time from the years 1940 (or prior thereto) up to about the year 1950. We understand that in about the year 1950, the responsibility for the setting of these threshold limits was shifted to the ACIH.

We will be pleased to pay you for any research or to pay anyone you might request to do this for us, as well as for copies of any publications or threshold limit values recommended by this Committee during the years mentioned.
