## ACCESS TO OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

In keeping with OxyChem policy and OSHA regulations, each employee has access to a variety of health related information through annual educational programs and individual requests:

1. The OxyChem Plant Safety Representative has a copy of the OSHA regulation that describes your Right Of Access To Occupational Health Information:

Medical Records: You may obtain a copy or review the data in your medical records by contacting the Plant Medical Department. A copy can be forwarded to the employee's personal Physician upon request.

Exposure Evaluations: You may review exposure data related to you or your job classification by contacting the Plant Safety Department.

2. OSHA Hearing Conservation Rules: The Plant Safety Department has information available regarding this regulation.

3. Hazard Communication Manual: The Plant Safety Department has a copy of the OxyChem Hazard Communication Manual on the guidelines established for the Plant Hazard Communication Program. Questions about the contents can be directed directly to the Plant Safety Department.

Material Safety Data Sheets are available through the Plant Safety Department for information as to the nature of hazardous or toxic chemicals.

4. Records And Documents: Available for review and/or copy upon request through the Plant Safety Department.
