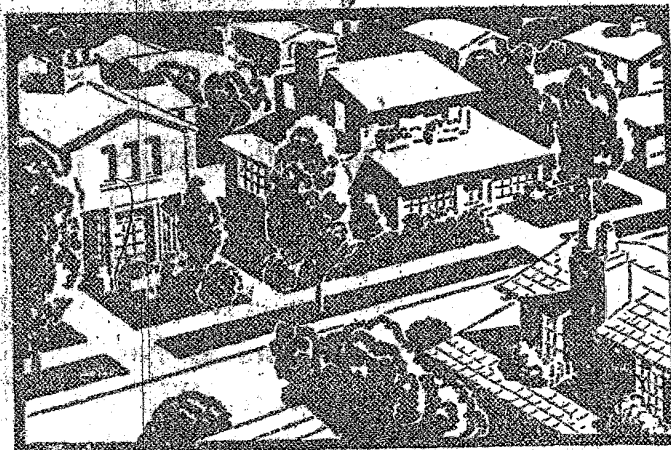


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Years ago open porches were considered to be quite essential to a home and the well-appointed house was always constructed with roomy porches. Of recent years, however, the open porch seems to be on the wane, its place being taken by the sun room or sun parlor, as it is variously called.

This change in design may be due to the influence of the city where the home owner preferred to do his lounging in privacy, or to a lack of space to spread out the structure.

The enclosed sun room has a distinct advantage over the open porch in that it can be used during the entire year. The use of the open porch is largely restricted to the hot weather of summer when the family can sit out of doors in comfort. At most the open porch was used three months of the year, the rest of the time being practically useless.

By enclosing the porch and filling its walls with many windows, the usefulness of the space becomes increased to a marked degree. During the hot summer months the windows may be opened and screened, serving as effectively as an open porch. Later when the temperature drops, the windows are closed and the sun porch becomes a comfortable, enclosed room. By installing a radiator or warm air duct the sun room is available during the coldest days. It virtually becomes another room of the house.

COST OF ENCLOSING LOW

The advantages of the sun room over the open porch are immediately apparent to the home owner who finds when remodeling that the cost of enclosing the porch is not excessive.

Its advantages far outweigh the additional expenditure. Thus the cost of enclosing the porch becomes an investment that pays big returns in use and comfort.
