Dear Mr. Larrison:

The following is the report of my industrial hygiene survey at King City, June 9, 1976. As you will recall, we discussed the general findings prior to my departure on that date.

I reviewed the environmental dust evaluation program with Mr. Madlangbayan giving particular attention to questions that might arise concerning the techniques employed. I also commended him (and you) on the efficient manner with which both the analytical work and the reporting of results are accomplished. I believe we are defining the work environment about as well as can be expected.

I discussed with you the program under consideration for meeting the new fiber limit (2 fibers/cc of air) that becomes effective July 1, 1976. This includes upgrading exhaust control systems in the two bagging areas, installation of a central vacuum system for better clean-up of floors, etc., more effective use of sprinklers in control of dust from ore pile and several innovations in material handling to reduce dust loss.

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
