### **BHRC-TC / Investigator Call Summary: June 2004 study update from Drs. Wong & Irons:**

- Research & travel expenditures within approved budget at this point in study
- Clinical lab operations remain at full capacity
- 2Q04 pathology review demonstrated 99+% diagnostic concordance
- Leukemia cases above, lymphoma cases below predicted accrual rate
- Pathology department referral of NHL cases will be revisited
- Numbers of confirmed cases will be updated in mid-year progress report
- "Control Selection" issues resolved by exclusion of out-patient Controls
- Exposure reconstruction, exposure assessment progress will be featured in Asilomar presentations
- Outreach anticipated as an informal discussion topic at annual conference
- Munich Benzene Symposium likely to provide first venue for study-related presentations
- Next PI calls scheduled for July 22<sup>nd</sup> (Richard) and July 28<sup>th</sup> (Otto)
