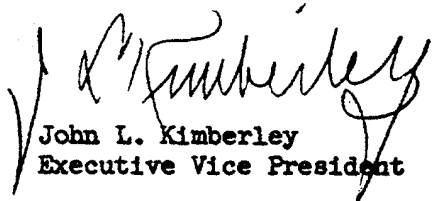
Dear Mr. Nelson:
