We are pleased to confirm herewith your continued appointment as a consultant under the following terms and conditions:

1. Take the lead in fulfilling Olin's commitments to prior Assonet employees with regard to vinyl chloride exposure.
2. Provide professional guidance for our industrial nurse, Mrs. Shea, in maintaining health records in compliance with OSHA and NIOSH regulations.
3. Consult with and advise prior employees concerning health problems resulting from exposures to vinyl chloride monomer and prior industrial injuries.
4. Take the lead complying with OSHA and NIOSH standards, in all matters concerning testing and medical examinations.
5. Consult with Olin management regarding all matters as necessary.
