Dear Dr. Kehoe:

Thank you very much for your letter of June 27, and the data which you so kindly placed at our disposal. I am enclosing the tables from which we have abstracted much valuable information. We are employing Table A in toto, and have constructed a single table from the data presented in your tables labeled J, K, M, N, Q, R. A copy of the reconstructed table is enclosed for your approval. Do you have the data which could complete the blood figures?

Could we impose upon your generosity for one more favor? I am enclosing the section of our manuscript which referred to your work of 1933. (This was written before we received your latest data, and I could probably make it fairly accurate from the charts which you have sent. However, inasmuch as the values given are of diagnostic import I feel that it would be safer if you changed them so that they might be in harmony with your present opinions. We will change the reference to a 1939 notation of a personal communication or, if you publish in the meantime, to a specific publication. I presume that the quotation which is appended to the analytical figures still holds.

Let me again thank you for your generous cooperation.
