BOARD OF OPERATORS
July 17, 1944

Item 13312 - FIBRE CAN MACHINERY

Equipment purchased for use in attaching fibre bottoms to cans is to be sold or junked and written off. Mr. Coolidge to follow.

Item 13313 - CRANES - WHITE LEAD PLANT

Efforts to sell these cranes to be continued. Mr. Coolidge to follow.

Item 13314 - LUCAS - GIBBSBORO

Dr. Van Stone to talk to Mr. Hollinger relative to equipment at Gibbsboro to be junked and written off or equipment that has been removed from plant but not taken off plant books.

Item 13317 - RAW MATERIALS

Dehydrol - Purchasing Department to make arrangements, if possible, to withdraw raw oil from Government stocks in Cleveland during latter part of August, thereby enabling us to maintain lower stocks than would otherwise be possible.

Turpentine - Mr. Goldberg to be asked by Purchasing Department to check on Memphis Turpentine, which was to be sold by R.F.C., if at all.

White Pigments - Purchasing Department to continue all efforts to obtain additional quantities of all types.

Antimony Oxide Black - Mr. Lemperly to report today relative to whether we received firm orders for manufactured material which were later cancelled. If so, were proper claims placed on prime contractor.

Item 13327 - DISINFECTANTS AND STOCK DIPS

Sales Department to take up through Mr. Goldberg the question of price increases for our Disinfectants and Stock Dips. Mr. Lemperly to follow.

Item 13328 - KEM-TONE PRODUCTS

Roller Koaters - Mr. Lemperly to see that special effort is put behind sale of Roller Koaters.
