In response to your formal complaint concerning safety and/or health hazards at:

**GARLOCK SEALING TECHNOLOGIES/DIV OF BF GOODRICH
1666 Division St.
PALMYRA, NY 14522,**

the Occupational Safety and Health Administration conducted an inspection there. That inspection was completed on December 21, 2000.

The results of our investigation of your complaint items are as follows:

- 1. Employees who have been diagnosed with mesothelioma and asbestosis have not been entered on the log. At time of inspection this was found to be valid. Citation issued.***

Attached for your information is a copy of the OSHA-2, Citation and Notification of Penalty, which was sent to your employer on January 10, 2001 and should have been posted at the workplace for at least three days after receipt.

If you do not agree with our inspection results, you may contact me, Ron Williams at Extension 3002 for a clarification of the matter. You also have the right to an informal review by the OSHA Area Director who may be contacted at the following location:

This review may be obtained by submitting a written statement of your position to the Area Director. The Area Director will provide the employer with a copy of such statement by certified mail. Your identity will be withheld unless you explicitly request that it be revealed.

Section 11(c) of the OSH Act provides protection for employees against discrimination because of their involvement in protected safety and health related activity. If you believe you are being treated differently or action is being taken against you because of your safety or health activity, you may file a complaint with OSHA. You should file this complaint as soon as possible, since OSHA normally can accept only those complaints filed within 30 days of the alleged discriminatory action.
