Effective immediately, the Hurst plant should discontinue the manufacture of the following ready-mixed Paco products:

4025	Taping Compound
4051A	All Purpose Compound
4051B	All Purpose Compound
4051M	All Purpose Compound

These products are being discontinued due to the fact that they contain asbestos. These products are to be replaced by 4051D All Purpose Compound which does not contain asbestos.

Please check and determine if the four products being discontinued contain any raw materials which are not used in other formulas. If so, advise me so that we can determine disposition of those items.

When you start manufacturing the asbestos-free formula, the following statement should be shown on the cartons:

ASBESTOS FREE

No Asbestos Has Been Used in the Manufacture
of This Product

Until our current supply of cartons has been used up, we will use self-adhesive stickers to apply this statement to the cartons. These stickers have been purchased by San Carlos and a supply is being sent to you.
