Dear Mr. Woodard:

Under separate cover, we are forwarding to you today by Railway Express fifteen (15) copies of the report of our experimental studies with asbestos minerals. These studies have been carried on at the Saranac Laboratory under the sponsorship of the Johns-Manville Corporation and other companies of the Asbestos Association.

The report is a fairly complete review of our experimental investigation of asbestosis, with the exception of a minor section devoted to lung cancer. As there was some ambiguity in the terminology in Doctor Gardner's notes on cancer in animals exposed to asbestos dust, we preferred to defer completing that section until after Doctor Vorwald has returned from Europe and has had opportunity to review the sections.
