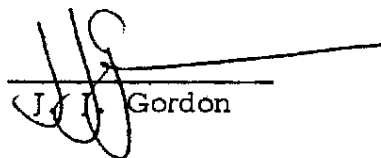

Under normal circumstances rail and motor carriers should not have the need for the technical information included in the MSDS form. Therefore, we feel that the expense for the distribution of this information can not be justified. Additionally, we would like to avoid the unnecessary concern which would be generated by a non-technical review of the MSDS.

In order to handle the abnormal situations, I would appreciate six copies of the Geon MSDS form so that I may forward them to the appropriate personnel within our Transportation Emergency Response System. Much of the information would expedite our response to transportation related emergencies.
