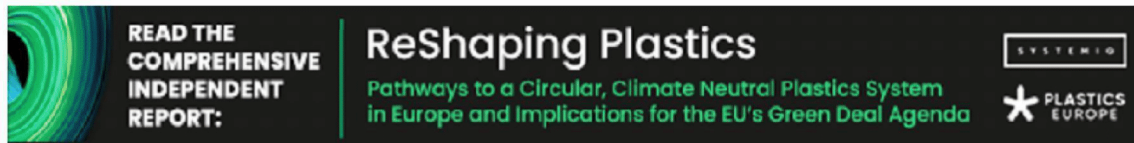

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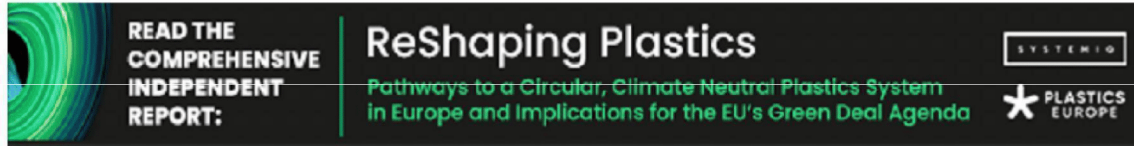

Dear 5.1.2e, RIVM colleagues,

I hope this email finds you well. You must be looking forward with some anticipation to the publication on 7 February of the PFAS REACH restriction! I will be travelling in the States on the 7th so will wake up to the publication being public!

I am delighted to see you have signed-up to the 13 February FPG webinar. As I write this mail to you, we have passed 1100 registrants for the event. As you can imagine the webinar is not going to go in to too much detail on the views of FPG to the proposal, but rather it is an opportunity to raise awareness of its publication, its content relating to fluoropolymers and indeed why and how stakeholders can get involved in the restriction process. Even so the chat function on Zoom will be open so you and all other participants can also follow feedback from those in the event. We will look to answer some questions that pop-up on the chat but will also follow-up after the call and look to answer by mail as many questions as possible.

FPG would be very happy to sit down with you in the coming weeks to share our thoughts on the proposal and to bring you up to date on the work we are doing for the restriction. You have indicated that this should be possible after the official publication of the proposal in March. Would the week of 3 April be possible for example? We would be delighted to welcome you to Brussels, or we could travel up to Bilthoven – we would appreciate the meeting being face to face. If others from the other 4 countries would also like to join (in person or online) we would also welcome that opportunity.

We are also talking with 5.1.2e and colleagues in the EC to find a suitable date to do the same.

Coming back to the webinar, we will reference RIVM in our presentation. We would like to mention we are in touch with Member States and that the dossier submitters will participate at ECHA SEAC and RAC meetings in the coming months. We will be mentioning that MS are stakeholders and can also respond to the public consultations.

I look forward to hearing from you, and to our continued engagement in the coming months.

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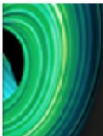
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
