6 BY MR. WILLIAMS:

7 Q Dr. Brody, just so I am clear with your
8 terminology, you have been referring to the term
9 disease.

10 Am I correct when you use that term what you
11 really mean in this context is the situation where the
12 cell divides abnormally?

13 A Well, no. Disease is a series of events
14 that can go from one stage to another. So we are
15 looking at the initial stages of disease, one of which
16 is cell division.

17 Q Okay. So when you were doing your
18 experiments where you were exposing your animals to
19 1,000 fibers per cc, you were trying to produce
20 disease?

21 A They have disease.
