Pursuant to our conversation, BFI Sinton may be able to accept the above referenced waste stream in accordance with the criteria established by Union Carbide in ten (10) days. As a re-iteration, please consider quotations reflecting the charges applicable to the container delivery fee, container rental fee, transportation and disposal of the asbestos related waste stream situated at the Union Carbide Facility at the Port of Brownsville to the BFI Sinton, Texas Landfill.

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As several different options have been addressed, I have catagorized each option for your consideration.

OPTION #1.....\$19.97 PER CUBIC YARD

- A: INCLUDES FREIGHT CHARGES, FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGES, INSURANCE CHARGES, DISPOSAL FEES;

- A: DROP SEVERAL TRAILERS (AS PER YOUR DETERMINATION) AT POINT OF ORIGIN FOR \$250.00 PER TRAILER PER WEEK RENTAL FEE (THIS WOULD ALLOW FOR UTILIZATION OF YOUR MANPOWER TO HAVE TRAILERS LOADED WHEN TRACTORS ARRIVED THIS ELIMINATING WAIT TIME CHARGES);
- B: TRANSPORTATION WOULD BE \$527.00 PER TRAILER (ROUND TRIP);
- C: DISPOSAL FEE WOULD BE \$15.00 PER CUBIC YARD;

- C: DISPOSAL FEE WOULD BE \$15.00 PER CUBIC YARD;

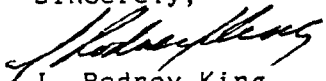
