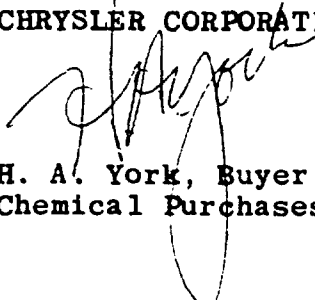

Upon satisfactory completion, I will proceed with the necessary approvals for your increase.

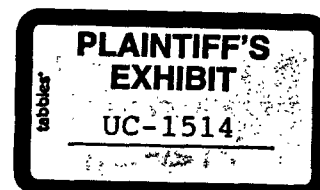

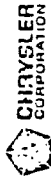

It was a pleasure meeting with you on May 11, and I appreciate the time you spent with me even though I was hours ahead of my scheduled appointment.

As we discussed with you the Calidria Asbestos dept. intends to lower the cost of C/L (18,200 lbs.) purchases of our EG-244, and to raise the T/L (5,950 lbs.) cost to better reflect true freight rates from our King City, Calif. plant to our various warehouses, Livonia, Mich. included.
