THE INFERIOR COURTS

CONYERS SAYS HE WAS KIDNAPED.

DEFAULTING WITNESS TRIES TO SQUARE HIMSELF.

Dr. Woods Was Forgiven by His Wife.
Dunnigan Got Off as a Simple Drunk.
Fighting Street-car Conductor Fined
For Smashing a Passenger.

There is trouble ahead for the women
who spirited away Jesse Conyers, the
missing witness in the Simmons bat-
tery case.

Conyers and Gusie Nelson, the
Swede woman who was the direct in-
strument who got Conyers out of
the way, were both arraigned in the
Police Court yesterday. Conyers was
charged as a defaulting witness and
the woman was charged with a mis-
demeanor for interfering with a wit-
ness.

They will neither of them be tried
until the Simmons case comes up on
Saturday.

Conyers filed an affidavit yesterday
protesting his innocence of any inten-
tion of trying to avoid testifying.

He said that he had no idea what
he was doing. The Nelson woman got
him intoxicated and had him taken to
San Pedro. He claimed that he was
unable to escape her and was locked
in a shack on the end of an old wharf.
He avers that it was a practical case
of kidnaping.



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
