Dear Mr. Behre:

You will recall that you were very kind in supplying us with a photograph for use on our cover page, this photograph being used since July 1935.

A few days ago we received a letter, which is attached, from Mr. J. M. Weaver who, as you may or may not know, is connected with the General Asbestos & Rubber Division of Raybestos-Manhattan, Inc., in Charleston, S. C.

These Southern asbestos manufacturers have been annoyed for the last several years by law suits in connection with the disease Asbestosis and you will note that Mr. Weaver is rather fearful that some shyster lawyer will seize upon the appearance of dust on the cover page of "ASBESTOS" and use that cover page as proof that dust exists in connection with asbestos milling, etc.

We have decided to accede to Mr. Weaver's request and discontinue, beginning with the January number, the use of the plate made from the photograph you supplied. The December number will, of course, have a Christmas cover which does not use a photograph.
