Dear Dr. Leatherman:

It has now been some time since seeing Mr. [REDACTED] with you and we should like very much to know the outcome of this case. We are particularly interested in this type of case and are anxious to complete our file up to the present time.

The blood and spinal fluid findings have been reported to you and I am enclosing a copy of the analysis of the urine for lead. As you will notice this is somewhat higher than normally found but, I believe, may well be secondary to his illness at the time. Also due to the covering of the container containing the urine with adhesive, it might possibly be due to some contamination due to splashing in transit.

Such further findings as you have found both on physical examination and in the hospital laboratory will be greatly appreciated.
