Because of the increased use of toxic materials, the services of an industrial hygienist are needed in the Industrial Relations Department to survey these materials, to designate methods of handling in a safe manner, and to perform research into the toxicity of new materials. These materials would include lead, mercury, solvents, as well as the new application of known toxic materials.

The industrial hygienist must work closely with the State Department of Health and our chemical and metallurgical laboratories in establishing safe working procedures. The candidate for this position should be a graduate chemical engineer who has had training and/or a minimum of 5 years experience in industrial toxicology.
