Dear Aubrey:

You will recall that the above claim involves an employee of our subsidiary company who has recently filed a claim for cancer of the entire body, which she alleges was caused "by an inhalation and exposure to chemicals over a period of twenty years". I appreciate your taking the time to review this matter with me earlier this week, and thank you for agreeing to represent Sprayon in this claim.

I have made copies of the correspondence already in my file which I am enclosing herewith so that you may review them once again. Also, pursuant to our discussion I will arrange to compile additional information regarding the claimant's work history at Sprayon and the potential hazardous measures to which she may have been exposed during her employment. In addition I will attempt to interview some of her supervisors and personnel at Sprayon Products who may have knowledge of her history of treatment for cancer in the past.

If possible I would like to arrange for you to visit the Sprayon Plant next month, to discuss this claim with Sprayon's Technical Director and our Industrial Hygienist. I will discuss this with you further at a later date.
