**Pastors**

ALAMEDA, Oct. 4.—City Manager C. McMillan has been authorized by the City Council to apply to the State Director of Finance for \$12,440 toward the development of plans for seven city parks.

Application will be made by McMillan to the State for assistance, including half-cost of plans, provided in the bill passed by the State Legislature setting aside \$10,000,000 for post-war planning by municipalities and counties.

Total cost of rehabilitating and developing Alameda parks was set by McMillan at \$25,320. It will include: Washington Park, \$8400; Lincoln, \$5970; Krusl, \$3880; McKinley, \$670; Franklin, \$1000; Longfellow, \$850; and \$4870 for the new Godfrey Park on Bayfarm Island.

**Loss of Ice Cream Plant. Blow to G.I.'s**

ALAMEDA, Oct. 4.—One of the worst blows dealt the morale of American troops on Okinawa was the persistent bombing of their ice cream machine by the enemy, according to Jack H. Dean, 106th Avenue, Alameda.

Dean, discharged over the week-end from the Navy, where he served with aviation units, said the Japanese mistook the canvas covering that protected the ice cream plant for wings of a B-29 and kept bombing it as a military target until the plant was completely blown to bits.

Dean returned to Alameda aboard the Admiral Mayo, which brought 5000 men here directly from Okinawa. He had been in the Navy three years, joining in October, 1942.

**Flogging for Rioters**

BOMBAY, Oct. 4.—The Provincial Government announced today revival of the Emergency Whipping Act of 1941, which provides for flogging of persons convicted of rioting and other charges. As Hindu-Muslim disturbances persisted the death toll stood at 26 and the injured at 174, while close to 700 persons have been arrested.

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
