

"Bach is the greatest composer of all time," Lyon declared today. "And he is by far the greatest composer of works for the organ. All organ music stems back to him."

"In my opinion," he added, "the Carmel Bach Festival is the leading one in this country, because it is so comprehensive, including all phases of Bach's compositions, both choral and instrumental. And I feel fortunate in having been invited to participate, especially since my friend and fellow organist, E. Richard Wissmuller, was the organ soloist last summer and undoubtedly developed a high degree of appreciation for Bach's organ music on the part of those who attended the festival."

Lyon said he was looking forward to the festival with keen pleasure, not only because of its musical significance but because it will bring him again to Monterey peninsula.

In Seattle, where Lyon has been organist of St. James cathedral for the last three years, and a member of the faculty of Seattle college, teaching organ, church and choral music, his annual series of recitals have attracted music lovers from all parts of the Pacific coast. In 1934 he became the first organist to play Bach's Art of the Fugue on this coast, and in 1936 in a series of recitals he presented the complete organ works of Bach.

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A camporee is an overnight patrol camping exposition where the patrols back-carry and pack in all equipment to the campsite and the patrols carry-out their program under their own boy leadership, without adult assistance. Patrols which qualify in the council camporee may participate in the regional camporal, which will be held at Alum Rock park, San Jose, in the fall.

Among the festivities to be enjoyed by the scouts will be campfire programs, games, contests, fire-by-friction and flint and steel, and church services. Patrols participating will plan and execute their own programs in addition.

There will be adult leaders and supervisors, organized to insure safe camping and to aid the scouts when needed. Adult supervision and attendance is required on the basis of one adult to each 16 scouts. The leaders cook and sleep in a separate area away from the patrols. A camp director, director of physical arrangements, director of activities, health officer, life guard, chief clerk, judges are required as a minimum staff for the camporee. In preparation for this even, local scouts have been practicing for the affair with week-end camp trips, hikes and district camporees.

Troops Arriving At Gigling for Annual "War"

Troops are now arriving at the great Gigling military reservation for the tactical inspection and annual military maneuvers in June. There will be no brigade maneuvers this year, but a concentration of the 30th Infantry regiment from San Francisco, 11th Cavalry and 2nd Battalion, 76th Field Artillery, from Monterey Presidio, and the 90th Observation Squadron, Air Corps, from Moffat Field.

From advance reports, the air corps squadron will bivouac at Monterey Airport this year, setting up camp there and making the port a base for air maneuvers in connection with the land troops.

Some of the 30th advance guard has already arrived at Gigling. The regiment will arrive in a body by truck on May 17 and 18. Maneuvers will last until the end of June.
