OSHA Physical Examinations

It is critical that you follow up with Dr. Joshi as soon as possible regarding scheduling of the 15 employees for physical examination and clinical evaluation. I have not discussed with him nor did I include in my memo of yesterday anything regarding the securing of previous X-rays on these individuals. When you see him you may want to suggest it.

Once Dr. Shelby's reports are received on those employees with normal X-rays, we will no longer have to rely upon him. Since he has effectively removed himself from the program already, it hardly seems necessary to formalize his replacement by Dr. Joshi. In addition if we get stuck at some time in the future, I am certain Dr. Shelby would be willing to order the X-rays and pulmonary function tests as he did originally. I would suggest that you secure the final reports from Dr. Shelby on Friday, September 12, 1975.

As we discussed last week, we should suggest that Harvey Butler have his X-ray reports sent to his personal physician. In addition we should make an effort to determine what additional study was recommended by Dr. Goldblum for Gerald DeBerry as indicated in his X-ray report.
