This letter concerns the above-referenced FOIA request, received by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) on July 1, 2025, in which you requested a variety of records related to EPA enforcement and compliance activities, including inspection reports.

The EPA has released records on an interim basis regarding our enforcement activities in response to FOIA request numbers 2025-EPA-04354 and 2025-EPA-04690, which represent requests submitted by the Environmental Integrity Project. Using these numbers you will find records responsive to your request by visiting the FOIAXpress Public Access Link Reading Room at <https://foiapublicaccessportal.epa.gov/app/ReadingRoom.aspx>. Enclosed, please find detailed instructions on how to locate and download these records using the FOIA numbers provided. The EPA has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying FOIA exemptions.

Your request remains open at this time. We will continue to release records to you on an interim basis as records become available. When your request is closed you will receive information regarding your appeal rights for any part of the EPA's response.

As you recently agreed upon with Ms. Kinshasa Brown of this office, the due date for this request has been extended to January 30, 2026. We greatly appreciate your understanding and flexibility.
