Dear Dr. Kehoe:

I was pleased to get your letter for various reasons. Most important being that, I am still very anxious to get a completed report relative to the observations you made here at our Plant.

In a general way conditions are about the same as when your survey was made. We have made several improvements in local ventilation particularly during the pouring of metals. I have recommended the isolation of the hazardous jobs for many years but due to the type of foundry building this has not been accomplished.

I was on the point of contacting you relative to any information you might have about tests for lead content in the urine which we might find practical for use here. We are still relying on the clinical observation of the employee and the blood examinations. So far, fortunately, we have not had a case of lead intoxication even though our alloys are containing more and more lead. We have gone over our sixth year now without even a mild case of lead intoxication, but due to the increase in our exposure I am anxious to get some more accurate data on lead excretion. If you know of any procedure, which I'm sure you do, that might be applied here we would appreciate knowing about it.

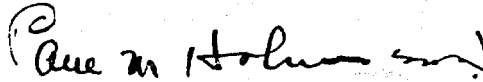
I am of course very interested about the American Association of Industrial Physicians and Surgeons and the American Industrial Hygiene Association. In recent
