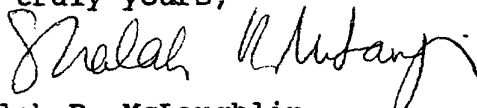
Dear John:

As you know the above matter was set for lump sum settlement on September 21. I traveled to Augusta on that date and learned from the Employer that they would not consent to the settlement unless _____ agreed to make repayment on the overpayment made to him by Sherwin-Williams.
