My dear Mr. Brown:

I have your letter of the 26th, with report of Dr. Gardner on asbestos dust experiments, and I would be very glad to carry on these experiments with him for another year, and stand our proportionate yearly share of the expense, the same as in the past, but I do not think we should carry it along for more than one year without having something very definite.

I glanced over the reports very hurriedly and really have not had the opportunity of reading them.

In talking with Dr. Lanza this morning, he said he had not received a copy of the report, and I told him I would ask you to send him a copy of the report with photographs.

Dr. Lanza said he would be very glad to come to your office and talk the matter over with you, if you wished, which I think would be a very good idea, if it meets with your approval, as he is still very much interested and has been of considerable help; in fact, it was only last month that they made a dust count survey of our Stratford factory.
