My name is [REDACTED] with BEUC, The European Consumer Organisation.

I write to share with you results from a test of fluorinated compounds in fast food packaging recently carried out by five BEUC members. The survey found that almost one third of 65 samples contained problematic fluorinated compounds, some of which are suspected to increase the risk of miscarriage or to impact the immune system. A short summary of the results along with a letter we send to MEP Christel Schaldemose, rapporteur on the EP FCM resolution, are attached.

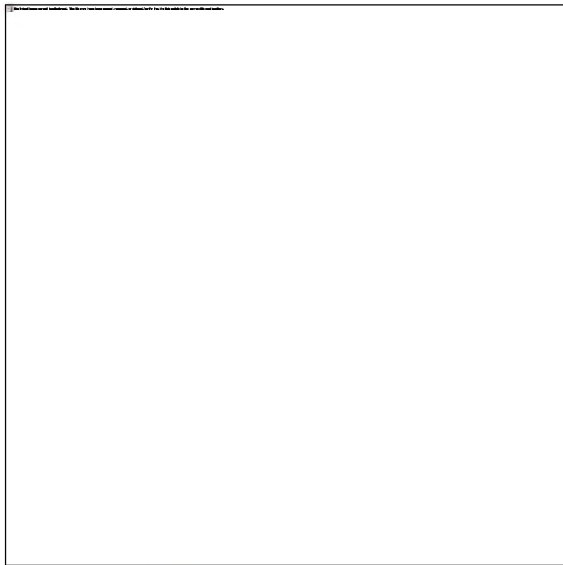

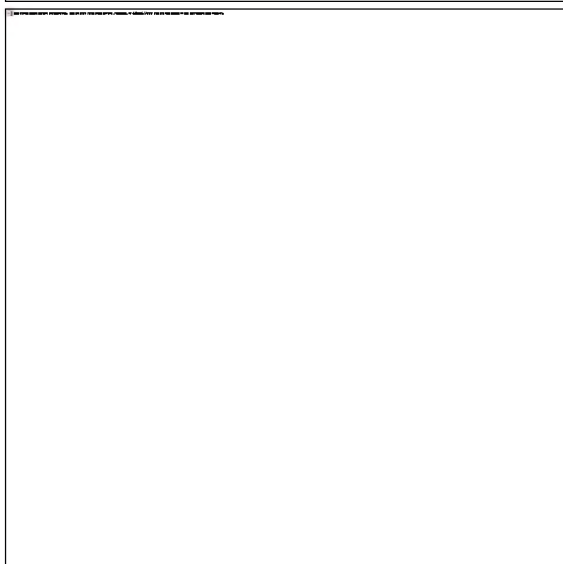
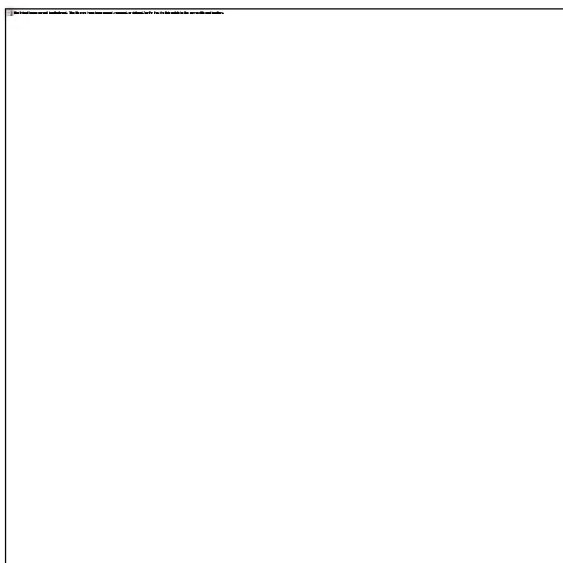
