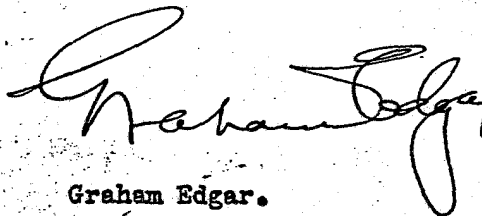
Dr. R. A. Kehoe.
