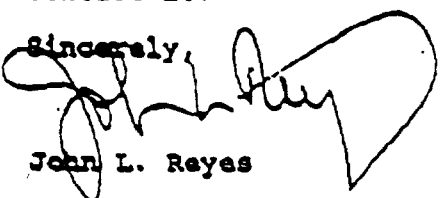
Dear Steve:
