For a whole lot of reasons which I would be glad to enumerate, if necessary, and based on my best public relations judgment, I strongly recommend that Monsanto conduct its own feeding studies with rhesus monkeys immediately.

I'm becoming more and more convinced that Dr. Allen's work, if left to stand as factual, will become a major emotional, psychological, legal and, indeed, public relations problem in the near future...and one which we are presently powerless to combat.

It would seem to me that the moral and social benefits to both this company and, indeed, mothers that would be derived from doing a thorough scientific study that either confirms or disproves his findings far outweighs the legal concerns that I have heard expressed.

I urge that we get on with the study!
