Dear Mr. Horst:

This will acknowledge and thank you for your order K-104 dated
February 7th for 25 tons SW Amosite.

The first 10-ton lot went forward from our Jersey City Warehouse
on February 8th.

The remaining 15 tons will come forward from Africa in approximately
six weeks.

As explained to you over the phone, we have had to revise our prices
on Amosite generally to reflect increased costs from Africa and also
some increases in our warehousing charges in this country. The cur-
rent price on SW f.o.b. warehouse Jersey City is \$145. per ton and
the price for SW f.o.b. dock New York or Philadelphia is \$132. per ton.

We propose to bill your order K-104 accordingly and trust that will
be satisfactory to you.

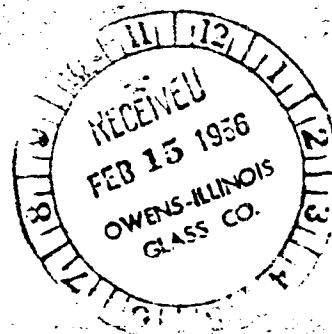
We are finding that SW grade is becoming increasingly difficult to
