After receipt of G. Welch's report defining the current and future size of those asbestos markets potentially available to Union Carbide, the next step will be to estimate the share of those markets which we can expect to enjoy by 1980. You and your staff should immediately proceed to prepare such estimates. The estimates should include not only a tonnage breakdown by market segment but also by Calidria product type. The estimates should be appropriately supplemented by text which describes the assumptions employed in arriving at the estimates. I cannot overstress the importance of this task to the future prosperity of our asbestos business.

Assuming that the Welch's report is available by April 12, 1974, I would suggest May 1, 1974 as the target date for completing this job.
